



Asbestos Policy Statement

DCC affirms that no new or second hand asbestos containing materials will be used in any of its premises and to this end will specify that no asbestos based products are to be used in their contracts for building, refurbishment or repair works.

DCC will undertake the necessary monitoring, treatment or removal of asbestos from its premises in a planned and rational manner and to this end:

- DCC will undertake a programmed survey of its buildings with the object of ascertaining the presence of asbestos containing materials within the premises.
- Prior to the appointment of any Contractor to work on or remove asbestos, DCC will satisfy itself of the competence of the Contractor, by seeking sight of appropriate accreditation certificates and licences.
- DCC will classify the risk presented by any asbestos containing materials found on its premises and will monitor, treat or have removed the asbestos in accordance with set criteria which will be revised as circumstances require
- The classification(s) for each building surveyed will be entered in a register and this register will be open to inspection
- Person(s) will be nominated whose name(s) will be displayed within the register to whom all enquiries concerning the register and its contents should be addressed. Pastor Joe Hayes
- Will deal effectively with enquiries for help related issues.
- Agree safe working practices with employees, Strategic Partners, Contractors and Sub-Contractors based on the HSE (HSG210 Asbestos Essentials Task Manual)
- No work on building is likely to involve asbestos, will start without reference to the register.
- Guidance and training will be given to all DCC employees, likely to come into contact with asbestos products, on its nature, effects and location.
- DCC will make adequate provision for the collection and disposal of all asbestos waste within its area, where no alternative service exists
- DCC will undertake to provide information to its service users concerning asbestos products that may be encountered.
- The Company's Policy on the Management of Asbestos will also apply to those companies working in partnership with DCC

- DCC will, as appropriate, revise and update this policy.

The protocol for all further investigation shall be the continued safety of customers, employees, visitors and the general public.
